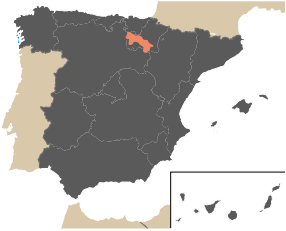




Cantos Blancos – Tempranillo Crianza



COUNTRY: Spain
REGION: DO Rioja
SOIL: Limy and sandy soil rich in minerals

USDA – Wine made with organic grapes

- Alcohol content: 13.5%
- Brix at harvest: 24.3°
- pH: 3.41
- Acidity: 5.4

Cantos Blancos comes from San Adrián (La Rioja del Reyno), in northern Spain, where the native grapes of Tempranillo grow. Rioja is undoubtedly one of Spain's top wine regions, with a winegrowing history that goes back to Roman days.

Background:

This is a Crianza wine to enjoy on every special occasion. It has an expressive nose with fruity and tasted aromas. Harmonious, fresh and with a pleasingly finish.

San Adrian is the warmest subregion of Rioja due to the warm winds from the southeast. Strongly influenced by the Mediterranean climate, summers are hot, with temperatures going up to 35°C. Due to the warmer temperatures, the region enjoys an annual average of 2,800 hours of sunshine.

The soil there also has larger proportions of silt and alluvial components, as well as ferrous clay. The vineyard sits at about 300 meters above sea level.



Tasting notes:

Dark cherry color with a purple hue. The nose shows classic varietal characters of intense dark berries, aged anise and toasted notes. The palate has full and rich notes of fruit and spice. Plum, raspberry, toasted coconut blend together in a long finish.

Grape variety

100% Tempranillo.
Vines planted in 1980.

Vinification

This wine is made from 100% organic and day-harvested grapes.
Vine training: Double Cordon Royat.
