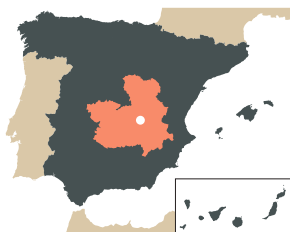


## Galerna – Garnacha



COUNTRY: Spain  
REGION: VT Castilla  
SOIL: Clay and limestone,  
800m altitude above sea  
level

### USDA – Wine made with organic grapes

- Alcohol content: 14.2%
- Brix at harvest: 25.5°
- pH: 3.2
- Acidity: 5.2

*Galerna is the wind that runs through the North coast of Spain. Like blooming flowers this wind usually arrives in in the spring. Just like the Galerna, this fresh and fruity wine will sweep you off your feet!*

### Background:

Even though it's not native to this country, the Garnacha or Grenache grape enjoys a great popularity in Spain, as it thrives in hot and windy climates such as ours. Anyone who loves fruit and spice will be delighted with Galerna Garnacha.

In the province of Cuenca near central Spain, our vineyard is located in an area where wine culture has been around for decades. It sits in an altitude of 800 meters above sea level. The continental mediterranean climate of this territory brings plenty of sunlight to the vineyard, and the clay soil retains water, essential for the health of the vines.



### Tasting notes:

An intense cherry red color and a violet shaded rim at first sight. The bouquet has notes of red berries. Supple tannins and a long finish on the palate.

### Grape variety

100% Garnacha.  
Organic vines planted in 2005.

### Vinification

By winemaker Ruth Fernández. Galerna Garnacha is produced from our Estate-grown grapes, which are organically grown. They are night harvested and cold macerated before the fermentation process begins. Clarified with Bentonite. Physical filtration. Cold stabilization. No animal product used.

### Made with Organic Grapes

Organically Farmed – No chemical pesticides or herbicides used. No GMO Yeast Used. Less than 100ppm Sulfites.
