Domaine du coq translates to “Field of the rooster” in French. The Gallic rooster (le coq gaulois) is an unofficial symbol of France as a nation, and nowadays it is often used as a national mascot. Our wine is made from Pinot Noir grapes, a variety that originated in France.

Background:

The Pays D'Oc Region is one of the central pillars of French wine production and exports. The area has a Mediterranean climate with hot, dry summers and mild winters, with most rainfall compressed into spring and autumn, also it's subjected to the influences of the Atlantic climate to the West and of the continent to the East.

Tasting notes:

Intense red color with a bright purple hue. Its bouquet opens with a basket of red fruits like raspberry and strawberry with notes of spices and peppermint. Well structured, this wine is balance and harmony.
